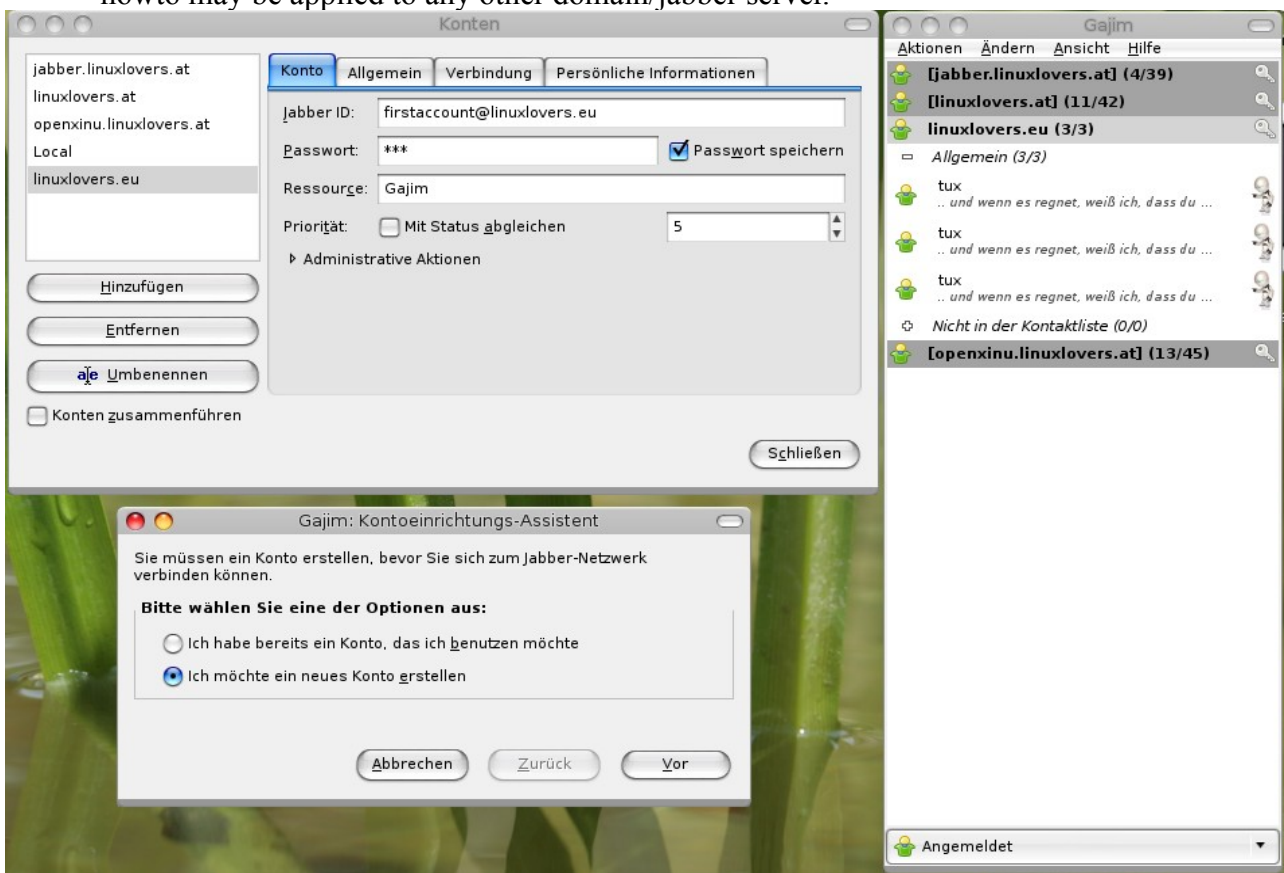


Requirements:

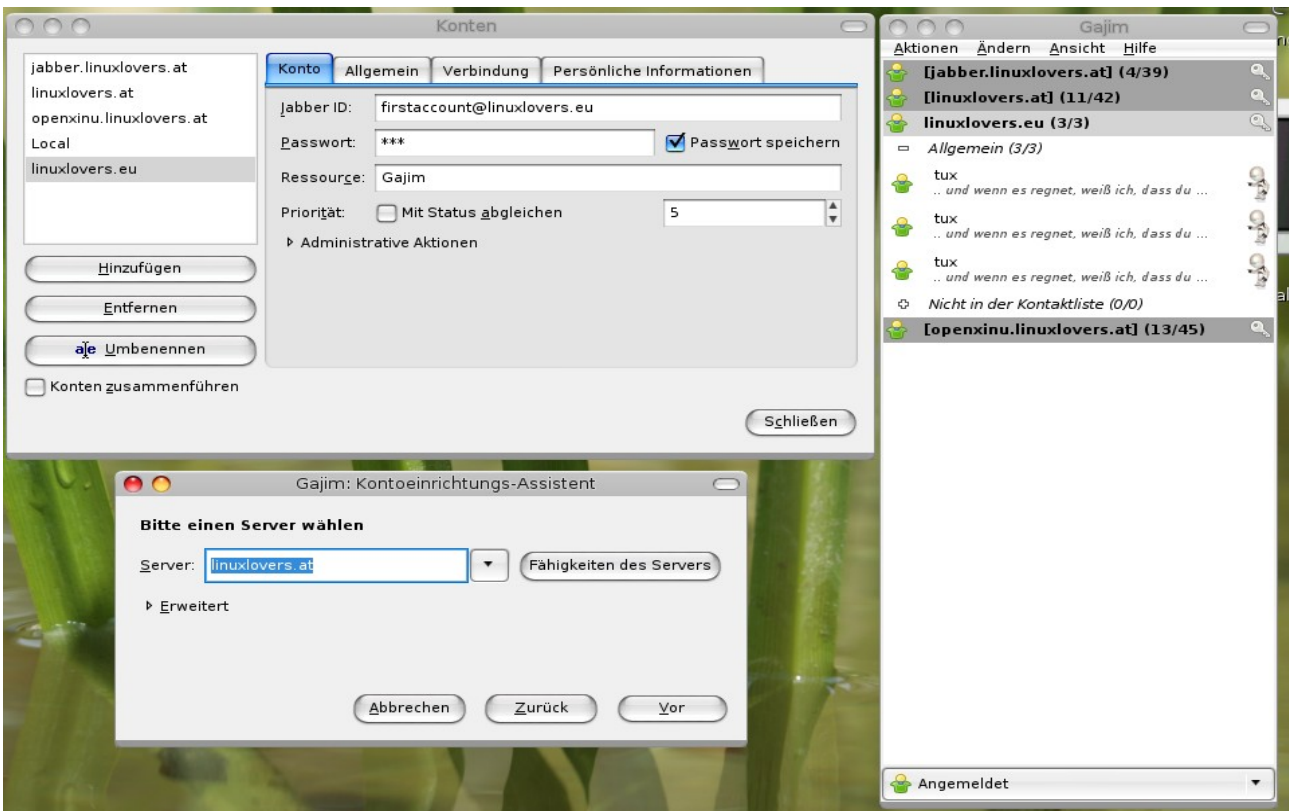
- Gajim (most likely svn version)
 - linux users (need svn and brain) do `svn co svn://svn.gajim.org/gajim/trunk gajim`
 - windows users get it from <http://blog.deshalbfrei.org/downloads/gajim/windows/>
- some time and patience, if you get it it takes ~2 minutes, if not, you will need days or probably years

NOTE: This howto is some kind of a productive comic strip...

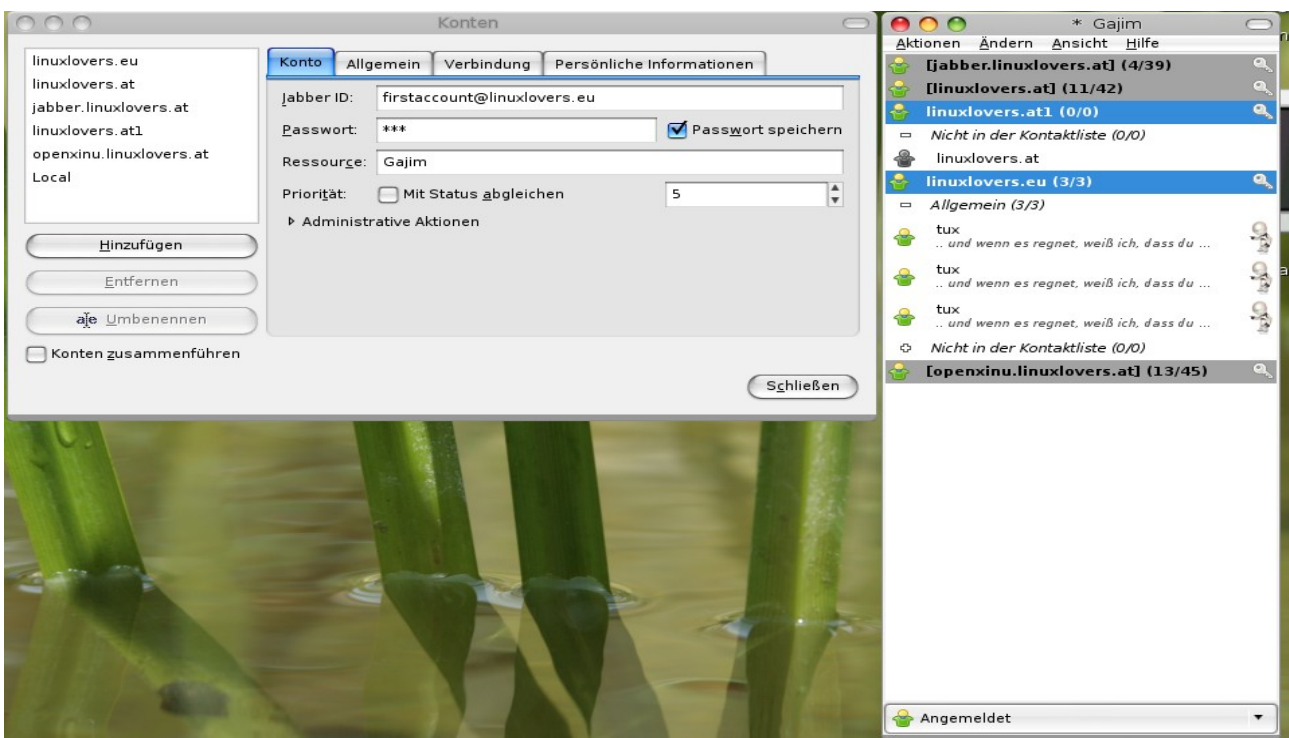
- 1) At first you need to create your second account to which you are going to clone the account you are using at the moment. Since this howto is made for linuxlovers.eu users who need to change to linuxlovers.at or jabber.linuxlovers.at I am using those domains, however, the howto may be applied to any other domain/jabber server.



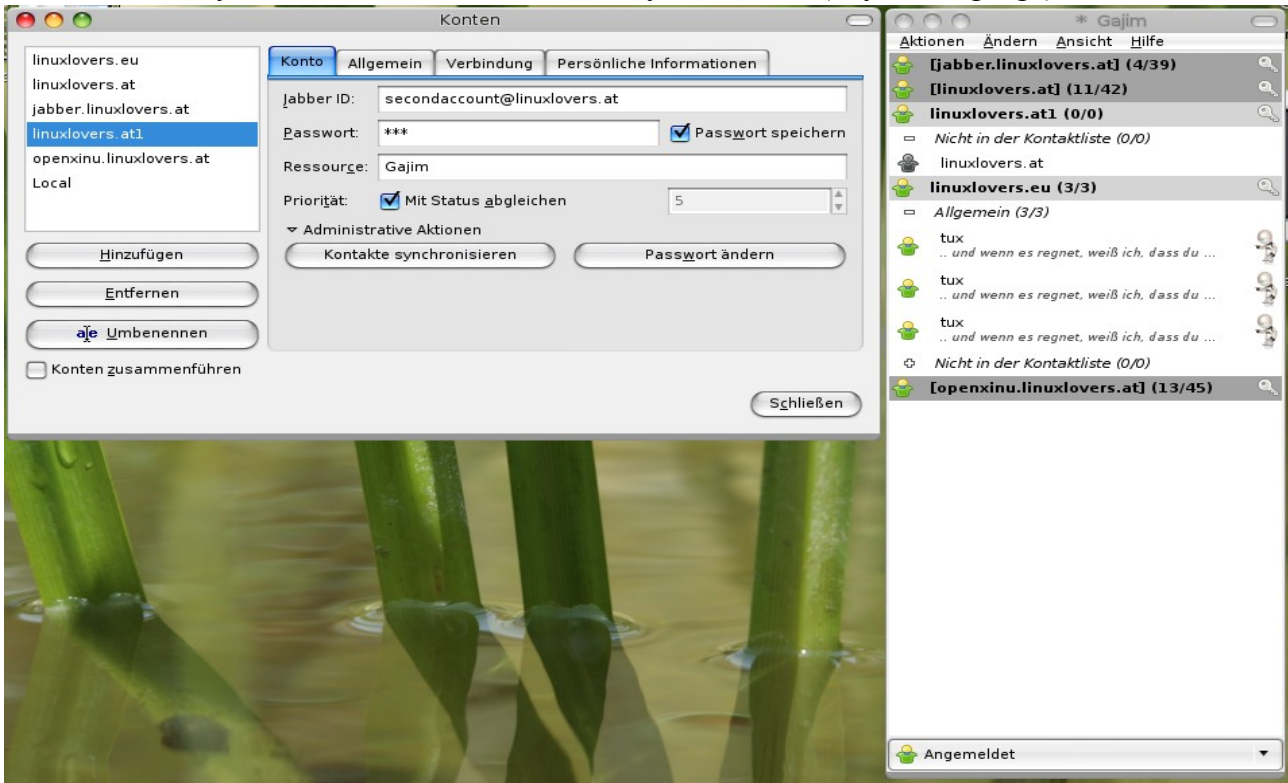
- Now that you have opened your account management (done through the menu or CTRL+A) you can continue creating your new jabber account on the new server, in this case linuxlovers.at



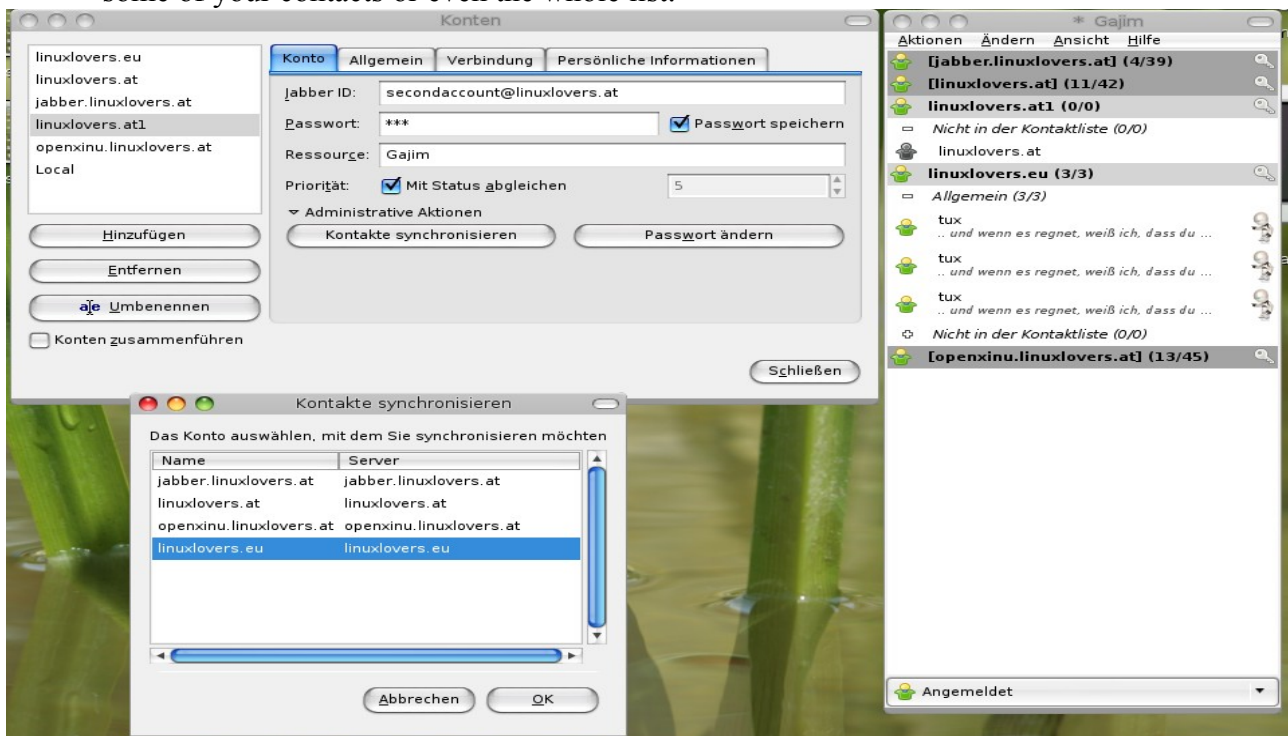
- As you can see in the roster, we have two accounts, the old one with some contacts and the new one which has no contacts at the moment.



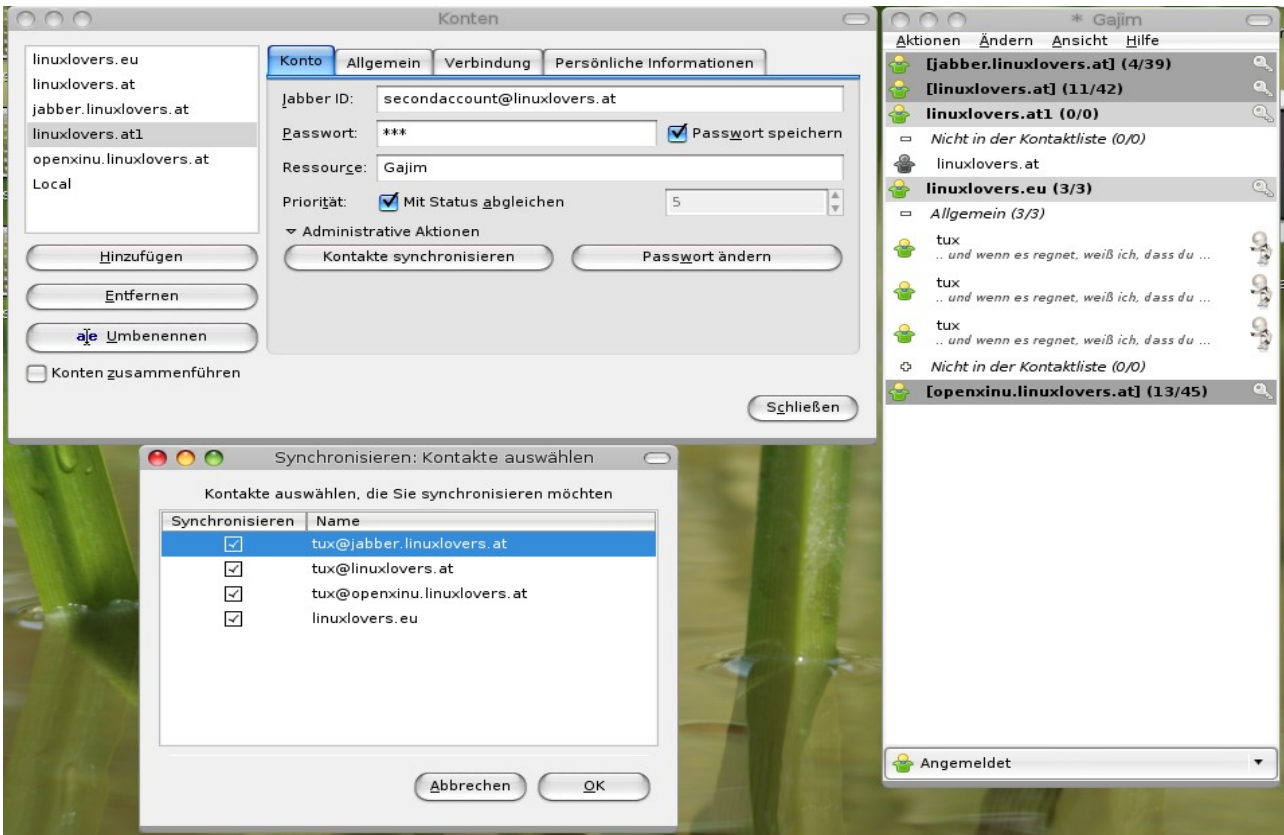
- 4) Now that we have two jabber accounts, we can start the part which is actually the syncing of those two very nice accounts. In order to do that, open that nice 'administrative actions' menu of your OLD account and click on 'sync contacts' (in your language).



- 5) This is the part where you can choose from which of your jabber accounts you want to sync some of your contacts or even the whole list.



6) Getting interesting now? Now choose the contacts which are to be synced from your old account!



7) Just for you to see, that we have all the contacts synced! Linuxlovers.at and Linuxlovers.eu with the same contacts, isn't a backup account nice? [yes it is ;)]
